- **How much does STEM Summer Academy for Girls cost?**
WVU Tech STEM Summer Academy for Girls costs \$350 per student. This covers all housing, meals, travel and activities for the week.
- **Are scholarships available for STEM Summer Academy for Girls?**
Yes, both full and partial need-based scholarships are available. To be considered for a scholarship, please fill out the scholarship section on the application.
- **Where will I be living?**
Students will stay in WVU Tech's Hogan Hall. Academy counselors will be living in Hogan Hall with the students and supervising meals, activities and projects.
- **Who are the STEM Summer Academy for Girls counselors?**
Academy counselors are female WVU Tech students who are majoring in computer science, chemistry, biology or a type of engineering. Our counselors have shown academic excellence and have experience as camp counselors, as resident assistants or with high school outreach activities. Counselors will live in the residence halls with students, eat with students in the Bears Den, help students with engineering projects and talk to students about their majors and college experience.
